- Artificial and live bait is allowed.
- Life Jackets are mandatory for all contestants when operating the gas-powered motor.
- Participants are encouraged to bring their own fishing equipment, life jackets, and any special bait of choice (worms, minnows, etc...).
- Extra boats are limited, bringing your own boat/pontoon is encouraged.
- Each contestant’s largest fish of each species will be weighed, recorded and the fish released back into the lake.
- Award ceremony and prizes will take place at the Annual Picnic, all child participants will receive a certificate and prizes from local sponsors and businesses.

The goal is to expose and teach youth about fishing and provide them an opportunity to enjoy the outdoors with a parent or mentor.
